# Monthly Report for \_\_\_\_March 2023

3/1- Received a call from a woman on Lower Oak St. She was having a discrepancy with someone whom she had obtained 2 dogs from last year. I was able to track down the dog's old licenses and vet records so she could register the dogs in her name.

3/8- A dog found by a private citizen on Rt 4 in Fort Edward was picked up and brought to the Village of Greenwich Office. The citizen was heading to Cambridge and stopped at the Village office. The clerk called me about the dog. I was enroute from a puppy mill rescue I had assisted on and was several hours from arriving. I called Scott Maguire, a Greenwich resident with whom I reside and a SHC former officer and current firefighter to come with my equipment and retrieve the dog. He transported the dog to the proper kennel for Fort Eward and I completed the paperwork when I arrived back in the area. No one claimed the dog. It was a male shepard mix wearing a flea collar.

3/16- A husky known as 'Dipsey' was found wandering loose by neighbors in her area. The dog lives on Notre Dame St. This dog has been loose several times before and the neighbors have been bringing her home. This dog was picked up by DC in 2021. In February of 23 I called her owner and spoke to him about his dog being loose. He was extremely confrontational. After transporting Dipsy to the kennel I mailed a notice of seizure to the home of her owner. The dog was posted online by the kennel. The following day at 12:30pm the wife of her owner contacted me looking for the dog. I explained the process to retrieve her. The dog would need a license and a rabies vaccine. Her husband became confrontational again, I received a call from the kennel manager. She relayed to me that he had been calling and making threats. I arranged for a sheriff to be at the kennel. I also called FEPD and asked Officer Huntington to assist the clerk if need be when the owner came into the office. The dog was picked up that evening by the owner. For the record it is the male in the home who is difficult. The female is not confrontational and is cooperative.

3/14- I received a call from a woman who would not identify herself or give an address. She wanted to register a complaint about her neighbor at 519 Lower Elizabeth St. Their dogs were barking on and off during the day. This was during our blizzard-like snow storm. It seemed the dogs were coming in and out of the house to be in the snow and barking and running around. The dogs were in their own yard. She described her neighbors as 'shady' people and business owners. I received no other complaints and this appeared to be more of a neighbor issue than a dog issue. I relayed the information to the Washington Co Sheriff.

3/20- I contacted the clerk about an upcoming ACO/DCO seminar. I tried to sign up and found it needed to be done through the office the officer works for. She emailed back saying she would take care of it.

### **Historians Report for 2022**

Over the course of 2022, we added additional hours by appointment for the public to be able to use our facilities for research with trained volunteers. During the summer months, we have many visitors looking for genealogical information. Usually at least 20 or so people. Telephone inquiries come from the general public, developers, and the curious! Many requests for information come via the internet. Usually, we can give some information or tell folks were to go to pursue their quests.

Over the years, we have continued to use the Howland Collection as a basis for expanding our overall collection of Paper making information and history. We have received several other special collections here at the Museum as well. From Doris Lasalle, who died at age of 102, we received her collection of materials that she used in the writing of Letters to Lura, including correspondence between Judge William Hay and Lura Anna Boise. The writings of Judge Hay have largely been discounted over the years, but in reexamination of his writings, we do find that he was spot on to his conclusions of many historical events. He tried to point this out to many local historians who tried to lay the blame for Jane McCrea's death on the Native Americans. William Hay tried valiantly to change that, nineteenth century opinion being against him.

Since my last report we have completed the scanning and identifying of our Slides Collection. Our latest scanning project has been the Stone Studio Negatives collection. This we did in cooperation with the Folk Life Center at Crandall Library, who offered information and assistance with our project. We were able to purchase a scanner specifically for the photo negatives and, with the help of our summer intern, we were able to scan approximately 3,000 negatives. The negatives are organized by last name of the customer, so that number covers the A's and B's.

In the Spring of 2022, I lead two walking tours, one at the Old Fort House Museum complex (May 5<sup>th</sup>) and one of Rogers Island (May 4<sup>th</sup>). In the Fall of 2022, I lead two more walking tours, one of Baker's Falls, showcasing the Baker's Cemetery which was a fairly active cemetery in the early part of the 1800s. Many Fort Edward families are buried there because State Street Cemetery was becoming full at that earlier period. This caused the early creation of Union Cemetery in the 1840s. The second tour was a walking tour of downtown Hudson Falls, originally called Sandy Hill. This also takes in our early paper making area from the side of the river, which included our old paper bag mills as well as our wallpaper mill, which are a part of our local paper making industry

This year, we have a few other walking tours planned with SUNY ACC. First, On April 26<sup>th</sup>, I will lead a Champlain Canal Walking Tour. Then, on May 10<sup>th</sup>, will be the "In the Path of Jane McCrea" walking tour. They can be scheduled through SUNY Adirondack Continuing Ed. Department.

I also assist the Union Cemetery with the editing of their newsletters, "Behind the Stones."

I have also consulted with our local Post Star Reporter on several local stories for the newspaper, providing historical photographs and background information.

I continue to be supportive of the Village of Fort Edwards Farmers Market project. We are currently working on a Canal Project for the Fall of 2023.

I am a member of many local historical groups and organizations.

Our Education Program has been able to operate at pre-pandemic levels this year and we were able to give presentations 3655 students during 2022. I was able to visit Hudson Falls Intermediate School during the month of May for Colonial Fest, a yearly local history event

hosted by the school. I gave a presentation on Historic Sandy Hill. Since that time, we have been able to give presentations to many other schools and youth groups and we have had a number of inquiries for programs to be done for this Spring.

We continue to use the Rogers Island Visitor Center as part of our tour for local school groups who visit us during the Spring. The day spent in Fort Edward often begins with a presentation at the Visitor Center, followed by a tour of the Old Fort House Campus, and a trip to the Champlain Canal Lock 7. Also, during the day, the students generally have a picnic lunch at the Old Fort House, utilizing our picnic grove. The teachers thoroughly enjoy themselves and enjoy giving their students a hands-on approach to local history using our Collection and artifacts.

We are looking forward to the possibility of acquiring the Annex Building from the Fort Edward Union Free School District to be used as an archival storage building for our municipality. This will bring our archives for the Town, Village, and Historical Association off of the Hudson River flood plain.
