Town of Fort Edward, NY Dog Control

DCO Report April 2024

I do not contract with WCPH to handle 10 day QT bite reports. I do keep track of all reported bites in the town.

4/3- I posted a warning put out by the National Weather Service on local FB pages. I reminded people to fill an extra water bucket and check fences, especially electric dog fences that would not be working if the power goes out.

4/3- I received a call from a woman who lost a pug wearing a pink harness and an Argyle license. She was dog sitting and the dog got out of the yard. I posted the dog in several places online and someone found the dog in their garage and returned it to her.

4/3- A driver called to say she found a dog right on the FE/HF line and picked it up off the road. As she was on the phone with me the owner came looking for the dog.

4/8- I received a complaint from a woman on Blodgett Rd about her neighbor's dog. The dog is friendly and comes into her yard and up to her car. She was concerned about the dog possibly chasing feral cats she feeds. I informed her I can not help her with the cats. I sent a letter to the dog owner asking that they not let the dog leave their property.

4/12- I was contacted by several people about a farm in Fort Edward needing a nurse mare for an orphaned foal. I created a post and shared it in as many places as I was able, including out of state connections at horse rescues. A nurse mare was found through an agency that specializes in nurse mares.

4/17- I received a text in the evening from someone with concerns about pitbulls coming from a lot in the trailer park on Burgoyne Rd. I have been instructed in the past by the WCS not to enter the park alone or engage with residents over dog issues there alone. I reached out to the WCS. A dispatcher pulled up the lot number and again instructed me not to engage with the party who resides there. The sheriff already had an open case there. I spoke with the wife of the original complainant and offered to meet with her to get her statement. I informed her without a statement I can not attempt to help her in any way. She refused to meet with me even though she said the dogs were dangerous and becoming a nuisance. Having nothing to back up a court filing, I contacted the town supervisor to find out if the town had any authority over what can be allowed with dogs inside the private property of the park. I informed him I want to help these people but they refuse to cooperate and give me what I need to move forward. He suggested I contact the zoning officer and the town attorney. I contacted the zoning officer who said he

had no say on dogs inside the park. I contacted the town attorney who informed me if the complainants feel they have a real problem and I have offered to help them, it is up to them to comply, not me to look for a case. If the witness does not wish to file a statement there is nothing more to be done unless they change their mind and I agreed with him and let our town clerks know if these people continue to call or visit the office they should be informed my offer to take statements is always open.

4/25- I received a call from the man who owns the pits in the trailer park. He is looking for help finding a home for the younger dog. His ex left the dog and told him to find it a home as she was not coming back for it. I have posted the dog online and I am reaching out to some rescues to try to find a place where he can surrender the dog.

4/26- Later in the evening on Friday night I received a text from a man in the group of neighbors complaining about the pits stating they were out again. I also got a call from the town clerk as they had contacted her. I called the WCS to find out if someone was in the area to let Andrew know the dogs were loose. This time I was able to speak at length with the deputy. He informed me he has taken the dogs home twice in the past with no issues. He did not feel they were dangerous. He explained that Andrew was left with both dogs when his ex moved out and that his mother was living there with him helping with the children. It is when the mother, who owns one of the dogs, tries to put them out they get loose. The ties for the dogs are brought indoors but sometimes they bolt before she can get them hooked up. He has no reports of anyone being bitten or attacked, his large concern was the dogs in the street causing a possible accident. He was going to contact me when he returned to the office with the mother's phone number so I could see about trying to find a way to help her, but he never sent the number. I called back the original man who texted and told him if he wished to file a complaint about dogs running loose he could, I explained that if I was going to issue an appearance ticket on neighbors complaints I still need a signed document. After hearing the issue and how the dogs are getting out he decided to wait a few days and see if I could help place the younger dog. Removing the problem seemed to appeal to him over a fine at the moment. I have volunteered to transport the dog to the Estherville Animal Shelter if they have room to take her in. They have helped Fort Edward residents in the past. I am waiting to hear back from them. With no county shelter, and private rescue groups full, there are very limited options for owners who need to surrender a dog. I only have complaints from one small group of neighbors. No complaints from anyone they claim had encounters with the dogs or anyone else. After speaking with the deputy I have a better understanding of the situation and both sides of the story.

2/27- I received a text from the town supervisor to see if I was aware the town clerk had gotten complaints the night before. I sent him a lengthy reply letting him know I had spoken with the sheriff about the issue as well as the original complainant.

4/17- I received a complaint from a woman on Marion St. about her new neighbor's dogs barking in the early morning before she goes to work and again when she gets home and puts them out. The dogs are barking at cars, people, or a leaf that blows by according to her. The dogs are not barking for more than 15 minutes. She requested that the dog owner put bark collars on her dogs. I informed her I can't make that happen but I could send a letter letting the dog owner know it is disturbing the neighbors. She understood and I sent the letter.

4/20- I received a call from a man who was walking on Samantha Dr. with his dog when a dog shot through the door of its home and ran toward them. A resident of the home immediately retrieved the dog and apologized, taking the dog back inside. There were no injuries, he just wanted me to be aware of the situation.

4/22- I received a call from a woman on Black House Rd about a dying cow. The cow had been at her neighbors farm down for 4 days with no water or food dying. I contacted ENCON who got back to me and informed me that she should call the sheriff or State Troopers. The cow died a short time later.

4/24- I received a call from a woman who found a very friendly dog near the library. She sent me a picture and I posted the dog online while I prepared to pick it up.

Within 10 minutes the owner called and arrangements were made for the dog to be picked up.

4/25- I received a call from a couple on Hill View who found a husky. I picked up the dog and transported it to the kennel.No one called me to report their dog missing. I posted the dog on line with instructions to contact the town clerk to claim it.

Town of Fort Edward Town Board: Exemption Agreement

GML 239m-3(c) The county planning agency or regional planning council may enter into an agreement with the referring body or other duly authorized body of a city, town or village to provide that certain proposed actions set forth in this subdivision are of local, rather than inter-community or county-wide concern, and are not subject to referral under this section.

TITLE: Exemption of Matters of Local Concern from County Planning Agency Review Agreement

The following actions shall be considered by the Town of Fort Edward Town Board to be of a local, rather than an inter-municipal or county-wide concern, unless such actions would result in the placement, replacement or extension of any structure into the right-of-way of any State or County highway; or unless such actions would result in new entrances onto State or County highways or any highway which serves as a border between adjacent communities:

Actions of Local Concern-

1. The granting of an individual setback, lot-line variance or an area variance for a single-family or two-family residence;
2. Conversion of single-family home to a two-family home;
3. The replacement or reconstruction of a facility in-kind, on the same site, within the same footprint;
4. Construction or placement of minor structure accessory or appurtenant to existing facilities, including garages, carports, patios, decks, porches, fences, barns, or other buildings not changing land use, density or drainage patterns, including upgrading of buildings to meet building or fire codes;
5. The construction or expansion of a single-family or two-family residence on an approved lot that includes the provision of the necessary utility connections and installation, maintenance and/ or upgrade of a drinking water well and a septic system;
6. Placement of individual mobile homes through site plan, special permit or variance permitting procedures;
7. Agricultural farm management practices, including construction, maintenance and repair of farm buildings and structures, and land use changes consistent with the generally accepted principles of farming;
8. Minor temporary uses of land having negligible or no permanent effect on the environment as determined by a negative declaration of significance under the State Environmental Quality Review Act by the referring body;
9. Temporary land use moratoria which do not act to restrict the actions of State, County or other governmental agencies;
10. The extension of utility distribution facilities to serve new or altered single or two-family residential structures or to render service in approved subdivisions;
11. Home occupations that do not require significant alteration to the building, expansion of water or wastewater facilities, or increased parking;
12. Placement of signs which are not visible from State or County highways or visible from any other highway which serves as a border between adjacent communities;
13. Designation of local landmarks or their inclusion within historic districts.

The following considerations shall apply to exempted actions under this agreement:

1. The exemption of the actions shall not preclude any board reviewing an action pursuant to the regulations and zoning of the Town of Fort Edward, at its discretion, from submitting any such action for referral to the County Planning Agency pursuant to the provisions of General Municipal Law Article B, Sections 239 l and m (GML 239). Such referral shall comply with and be bound by all requirements and time frames associated with said section.
2. Any board reviewing an action pursuant to the regulations and zoning of the Town of Fort Edward may at any time request the assistance of the Washington County Department of Planning and Community Development to assist in making its determination of the applicability of these provisions.
3. The County Planning Agency shall be sent a copy of any public hearing notice required for any project, which would normally be subject to County Planning Agency review pursuant to GML 239 at least ten (10) days prior to the date of such hearing.
4. The Washington County Planning Agency shall be provided with a copy of any approval issued for an exempted action.

This agreement shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until July 1, 2028 or until such time as it may be amended by one or both parties.
