OTHERS PRESENT: Peter Ives, Brian Brockway and Town Clerk Aimee Mahoney

Councilman Suprenant: Due to the water tower being on Town property we should be putting any potential funds received as rent in the general fund.

Supervisor Fisher went through the proposed 2022 budget line by line with the Board

Supervisor Fisher:

- Revenue in the general fund doesn't change much from last year
- Need to check with Assessor on the Fort Hudson PILOT
- The freight house at the train station needs the roof fixed and the building secured
- Visitor's Center needs to be painted as well as the pump house at the pool

Councilman Suprenant: Contact Mike Gray at the County for painting the Visitor's Center and the pump house, we can supply the paint and he can supply the manpower.

Brian Brockway: The garbage truck is getting older and you may want to increase the general repairs budget line in case something happens to it.

Councilman Suprenant: I do not believe we should put any more money into garbage, when the truck dies we should get out of the garbage business.

Councilman Middleton: If we do away with garbage it affects the elderly population that only has 1 bag a week.

Supervisor Fisher: Get prices on a used garbage truck.

Councilman Middleton: I suggest putting the garbage back on the taxes by referendum, that way the people will have a say in whether we do away with it or not.

Peter Ives: In the highway fund state aid imp. Went from \$70,000 to \$140,950 due to CHIPS money and that figure could increase depending on the amount received.
